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MINUTES

Minutes of the meeting of Garthorpe and Fockerby Parish Council held at

Garthorpe Village Hall on 17th October 2017 at 7-30 p.m.

17/10/001. Present: Cllrs. J. Martinson (Chair), J. Smith (Vice Chair), W. Bradwell, J. Marks, J. Preston, B. Reed, S. Simms Ward Councillor J. Reed.

Apologies: Cllr. D. Armstrong.

The Chairman welcomed Cllr. J. Reed to the meeting.

17/10/002. Declarations of Interest: To note any declarations of interest made by Councillors in respect of items on this meeting's Agenda (in accordance with the Council's Code of Conduct and the Localism Act 2011). None.

17/10/003. Minutes of the meeting held on 15th August 2017: The Minutes were accepted as a true record, as proposed by Cllr J. Martinson and seconded by Cllr. J. Smith.

Minutes of the Planning Meeting held on 12th September 2017: PA/2017/1428. The Minutes were accepted as a true record as proposed by Cllr. J. Smith and seconded by Cllr. J. Marks.

Minutes of the Planning Meeting held on 3rd October 2017: PA/2017/1494. The Minutes were accepted as a true record as proposed by Cllr. J. Smith and seconded by Cllr. J. Preston.

17/10/004. Matters arising from the Minutes: The enquiry regarding extending a Boundary adjoining the Playing Field. Cllr. J. Marks declared an interest and left the room. The Clerk had a copy of the Title Deeds and Plans for the Playing Field. Ward Councillor Julie Reed advised that a Boundary is a Boundary and should be kept that way. The Parish Council noted that some residents had encroached upon the Playing Field and unanimously agreed

that it was not in the Public's best financial interest to pursue this at the present time. It was unanimously agreed that the existing encroachments be acknowledged but allowed to remain as long as they are well maintained and do not increase in size. No other changes to the Boundary would be permitted. A letter will be sent to the residents confirming this.

17/10/005. Parish Partnership: Dave Sanderson from NLC was due to attend the meeting. The Clerk will email him for additional information.

17/10/006. Ward Councillor Update: Ward Cllr. Julie Reed addressed the Parish Council.

Crowle Community Cinema is now open and running 1st Wednesday of every month starting at 12.30 and also the 3rd Friday of the month 7.30pm. NLC have funded the screen. The call connect bus can be used to access the daytime screening. Details are on the Village noticeboard.

Across the Isle there have been several burglaries and the Police have responded to this. Cllr. Reed has a letter from Inspector Harvey assuring us that there have been arrests and extra policing resource has been allocated. Additional patrols are in operation.

The council has issued a beware of bogus traders warning.

The council in conjunction with the Safer Neighbourhood partners have launched a Community Safety Fund which allow neighbourhood watch groups and other community groups to apply for funding. This is aimed at improving community safety.

Safeguarding week is from 6-10th November. Various events are being held at North Lincs Learning Centre.

North Lincs and Goole Hospital Trust is holding an engagement event to update on hospital news. They are also offering a free health check.

The North Lincolnshire Tourism Team are looking at producing an Isle wide brochure to include places to visit, eat and stay. It is intended that Axholme North will have a specific page in News Direct for advertising local events.

The In Bloom project seeks to engage with volunteers in the community to take on prominent areas of the village to showcase our towns and villages. As Ward members Cllrs. J. Briggs and J. Reed have requested that we receive £300 to support our community. The Clerk will apply for this funding.

As The Armed Forces Champion for North Lincs Council, Cllr. J. Reed will be working on some projects. We will receive a survey request soon. There will be events in the near future. Cllr. J. Reed will keep us updated.

17/08/013. Streetlights, Highways and Footpaths: Cllr. J. Martinson asked if the middle part of Back Lane could be scraped. Ward Cllr. J. Reed will make enquiries for Highways to inspect the road.

17/08/014. Matters for future discussion: Cllr. J. Martinson asked about ordering the Christmas Tree. Cllrs. J. Smith and W. Bradwell will make enquiries.

Cllr. J. Martinson had been approached to see whether the location of the Christmas tree could be moved to the grass in front of the church as this is a more prominent area. The electrical supply would need to be moved. The Councillors agreed that a site visit should take place in daylight.
