Rural crimes

Information from Inspector Craig Leitch with regards to rural crimes occurring.

Offences:

1. What – Outbuilding burglaries including stables, barns and containers. High value items including pedal cycles, quad bikes and tools are being taken, including ride-on mowers and mini diggers.
2. Where – Locations are spread across all of N.Lincs, but all premises are all close to easily accessible main roads – (Including M180 near to Brigg + Belton / also A161 near to Graiselound and Haxey have been targeted)

3. When – offences are mostly occurring overnight.
4. How – entry is gained most often via doors, either attacking locks or prising or forcing entry.

Request for people that have such property to review their security – make sure their CCTV cameras / security lights are clean and in good working order. Anyone who sees suspicious activity to report immediately.

Police and Crime Commissioner election For the HUMBERSIDE Police Area

1. An election is to be held for a Police and Crime Commissioner for the Humberside Police Area.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the Police Area Returning Officer, East Riding of Yorkshire Council, County Hall, Cross Street, Beverley, HU17 9BA by e-mailing electoral.services@eastriding.gov.uk or telephoning 01482 393300, or go to www.eastriding.gov.uk/candidates
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Police Area Returning Officer at County Hall, Cross Street, Beverley, HU17 9BA between 10am and 4pm on any working day after publication of this notice but no later than 4.00pm on Thursday 8 April 2021.
4. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 6 May 2021.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Monday 19 April 2021. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>
6. The £5,000 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom. Electronic transfer of

funds is the preferred method of payment and details for making payment can be obtained by contacting the Electoral Services Team either by e-mail at electoral.services@eastriding.gov.uk or by calling 01482 393300. 7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Tuesday 20 April 2021. 8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Tuesday 27 April 2021. 9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Thursday 6 May 2021. News from the Village Hall (30th March 2021)

Committee members are now calling at houses in the village to renew and sell Lucky Number tickets. Lucky Numbers is a prize draw "club" run by the Village Hall Committee. An annual ticket costs £5*. That ticket is entered into a draw every month, for which the prizes are £20, £10 and £5, and into the Christmas Special Draw (prize usually £50 but at the Committee's discretion). Prize money is delivered to the winner's home; winners' names are also placed on Facebook and on noticeboards around the village. Anyone in the village can hold a ticket. More than 40% of the money raised is returned in prizes and the rest makes a vital contribution to the running costs of the village hall. ***If you are joining for the first time in 2021, your ticket will cost £3.75, because you will have missed the first 3 draws of the year.**

Although the amounts are small (around £80 - £120 depending how many apply that year) the grants help to buy books, equipment, travel expenses etc.
