PARISH COUNCIL REPORT – AUGUST 2023

A Planning meeting was held on 17th July – attended by 6 councillors and two members of the public.

PA/2023/1010 Walker, Land east of Brandon House, Luddington Road – planning permission to vary condition 2 of PA/2020/2026. Namely to revise the elevations of the dwelling.

PA/2023/1064 Bradwell, land south of Station Road, Garthorpe – outline planning permission for residential development with appearance, landscaping and scale reserved for subsequent consideration. (This is a change of wording from the original application).

MICRO GRANT FUND – Applications can be considered for the following:

Support small un-constituted groups who would be ineligible to apply to the main fund.

Support talented individuals' resident in North Axholme who are able to demonstrate excellence in sport/art or culture, supported by independent evidence, e.g. selection to a recognised governing body national sports squad, working with professional artists, practitioner in a residence, mentoring or master class setting.

1. Support participation of local community in activities not available in the local community
2. Provide grants up to a maximum of £300.
3. Enhance quality of life for residents
4. Contribute to vibrant, healthy, successful and sustainable communities.

5. Promote community spirit and encourage community activity.
6. But NOT for a project already receiving SSE funding.

Mark's stories were interesting and reflected his personal connection with Mike Oldfield.

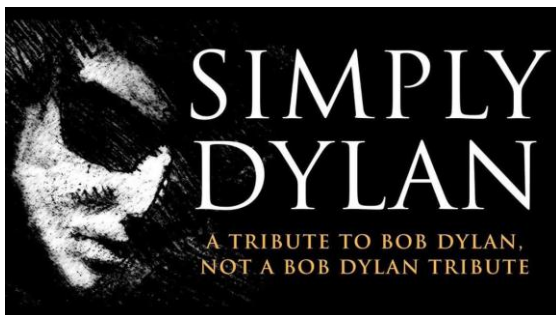

Incredible edibles

On the Wellbeing front, the Yoga class continues to flourish with more and more people joining it. It is held on Mondays at Reedness Primary School, bringing people together on a weekly basis and also bringing income to the school - an essential part of our community. Yoga is an ideal activity for our wellbeing as it focuses on the breathing as well as the yoga movement/hold. Whilst doing this there is little room to focus on the worries of everyday life. The sessions for the rest of the year are as follows:-

August 7th, 14th & 21st

September 11th & 18th

October 2nd, 9th, 16th, & 23rd

November 13th, 20th, & 27th

December 4th & 11th.

Our Incredible Quilting course, originally intended to be 10 sessions has expanded slightly to 14 sessions but this 14th one (Friday 21st July) will definitely be the last as there is only a handful of us to finish our quilts.

Now on to gardening related events with IEM. The planters are looking so, so pretty throughout our villages.

We also ran a gardening workshop in July all about herbs. It was in fact only a small group who attended but turned out to be a marvellous session full of everything that can be done with herbs. Herbs are not just for cooking!!! Everyone without exception learnt something from the host, Jules, who was so knowledgeable on the different uses of herbs. All attendees took home a pot of herbs of their choice to nurture.

All that remains to tell you about is July's craft session on Alchemy or put simply Natural Dyeing. This was a 3 hour session for a small group due to the nature of the subject. Abigail was our expert tutor and gave us lots of information on dyeing going back to Tudor times and beyond. It was totally fascinating to learn how Dyeing has developed over the years. The stark difference between the early years of experimentation to produce different colours, and how items are manufactured today is phenomenal. We used the skin of onions, the plant Madder and the plant Weld to do our dyeing. The colours produced varied from bright yellow/olive green for the Weld plant, gold/light brown for the onion skins and red/orange/peach for the Madder plant. The tones produced depended on the length of time emersed in water and then boiled as well as the type of cloth used. It was not an exact science in days gone by of course.

Our Hobby Huddle takes place every month on the second Friday and is at Garthorpe Village Hall. July's huddle had as many people as last month but some different faces, so this means we are growing. Bring some sort of hobby with you to occupy the time or just drop in for a cuppa and a chat. This is FREE every month. We have a raffle prize each time which you may take part in if you wish, and the prize

is connected in some way to the ethos of Incredible Edibles
